Child Safe Environments

The Children’s Protection Act (1993) requires a wide range of organisations to provide a child safe environment and have a firmly embedded commitment within their culture and policies to promote safety wellbeing of children and young people.

This full day course will support individuals to understand their obligations under the Act to provide child safe environments within their role in working with or alongside children, including an overview of legislation, reporting, responding to a disclosure, values and attitudes and prevention.

Organisations that must provide a child safe environment:

You must provide a child safe environment under Section 11 (2) of the Children’s Protection Act (1993) if you are working in any of the following fields:

- health • welfare • sporting • recreational • religious • spiritual • childcare • legal
- residential • cultural • entertainment

This applies to:

- government organisations • local government organisations • non-government organisations
- sole traders • people working in partnerships
